HART IN HISTORY – MED DEPLOYMENT 1975 – PART 4 (FINAL!)

- 7-12 December: Gibraltar. The Rock! Friendly, English-speaking folks. We all did lots of Christmas shopping, pub hopping, watched the rock moneys (Gibraltar apes) and toured the tunnels inside the rock. One of my favorite spots was St. Michael's Cave. It is a huge cave with massive stalactites and stalagmites. When I first entered, the pillars were bathed in colored lights while an unseen organist played "Amazing Grace". Absolutely beautiful.
- 15 December: brief stop for fuel, Punta Delgado, Azores. No liberty
- 20 Dec: brief stop for fuel, Bermuda. A huge "Bravo Zulu" to Captain John Rohrbough, who sweet-talked the pilot into allowing us to leave that day, rather than stay overnight, even though rules said ships could not depart after a certain hour and we were well past that hour when fueling was complete. The pilot's only demand was that he be given the conn for the transit.
- 22 December: arrive Norfolk, Virginia. The natives were friendly

Light at Fort Williams. Also view the Memorial to the WWII Liberty Ships next to the

sparkplug shaped lighthouse.

12:30pm Tour will end in Portland's historic Old Port waterfront for free time. Walking maps and

coupons for shops and restaurants provided.

Note: Coach will return to the Best Western Merry Manor if anyone doesn't want to explore the Old Port. Guests staying in the Old Port for lunch on their own will find their

own transportation back to the hotel when ready.

We will be staying at the Best Western Merry Manor Inn,700 Main Street, South Portland, Maine 04106. We have negotiated a special rate of \$129 per night, plus tax (single or double occupancy – extra person adds \$10 a night). The special rate is available for three days before and after our contracted dates (Oct 13-19) for shipmates who would like to stay longer to enjoy the South Portland area. Hotel fees include a free buffet breakfast each morning. Although the Merry Manor no longer has a shuttle bus available, shipmates arriving at the airport should take a taxi or ride share to the hotel and the Merry Manor will reimburse the cost.

You do NOT need to stay at the Merry Manor in order to participate in all reunion activities, including the hospitality suite. (The free breakfast buffet, of course, is limited to Merry Manor guests.)

Each shipmate must contact the Merry Manor directly to make their reservations. Call 207-774-6151 and tell the receptionist you are with the Thomas C. Hart reunion group for the special rate.

If you have questions about hotel services please contact the Merry Manor directly.

If you have a name tag lanyard from a previous reunion, please bring it along.

The Hospitality Suite will be open starting on Tuesday evening. Bring along your photos, cruise books, and other Hart memorabilia for display. The room will be secured when not in use.

The Merry Manor will provide a free one hour beer, wine, cheese, cracker, and cookie reception in the Hospitality Room at 5 PM Wednesday October 15th.

CANCELLATION POLICY: Cancellations prior to September 15, 2025 will receive a full refund for tour and banquet charges. You must contact the Merry Manor directly if you need to cancel your hotel reservation. The reunion registration fee is not refundable.

NOTE: Because membership dues from the Thomas C. Hart Veteran Association provides the seed money for initial reunion costs, as well as defraying other expenses, all shipmates attending the reunion must be members of the TCHVA. The good news is that you can sign up and pay dues at the reunion. Cost is \$10 a year, with two years collected at a time to cut down on admin. Please come to the reunion even if you are not sure of your TCHVA status. If you are not a member when you arrive, you will be one when you leave.
